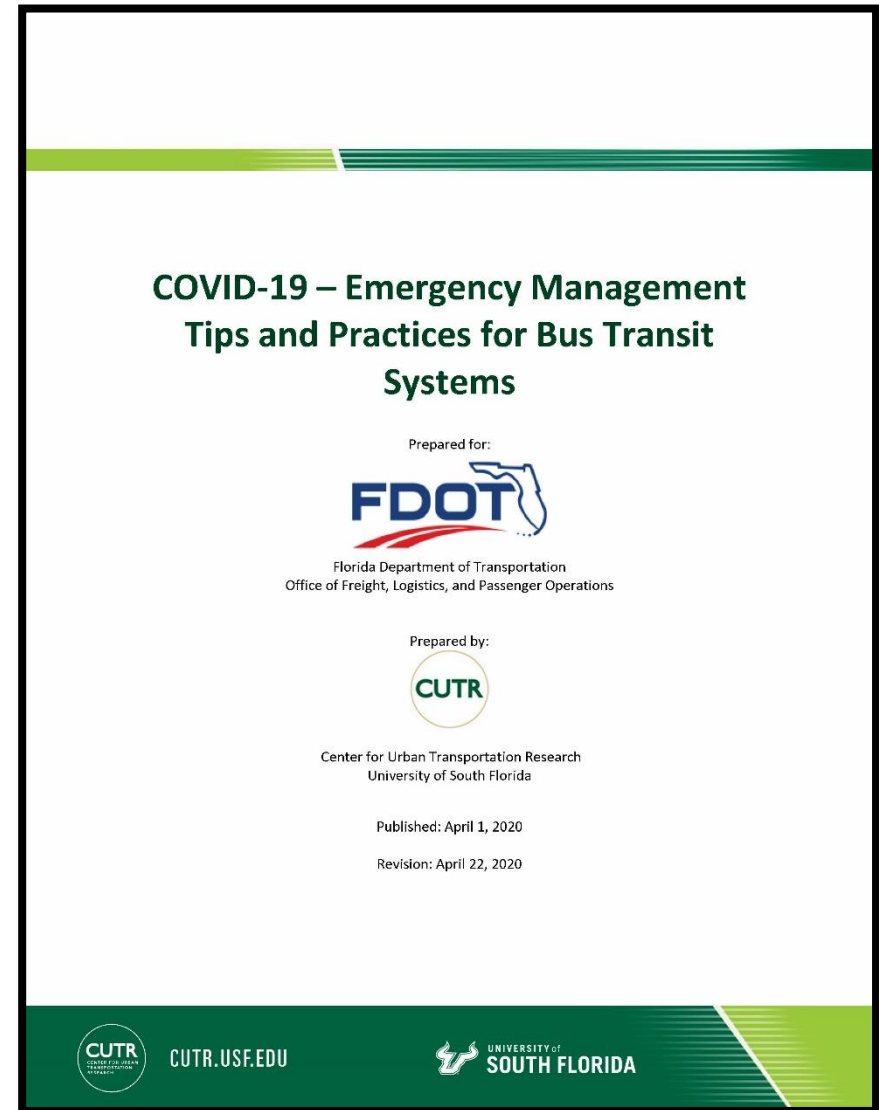

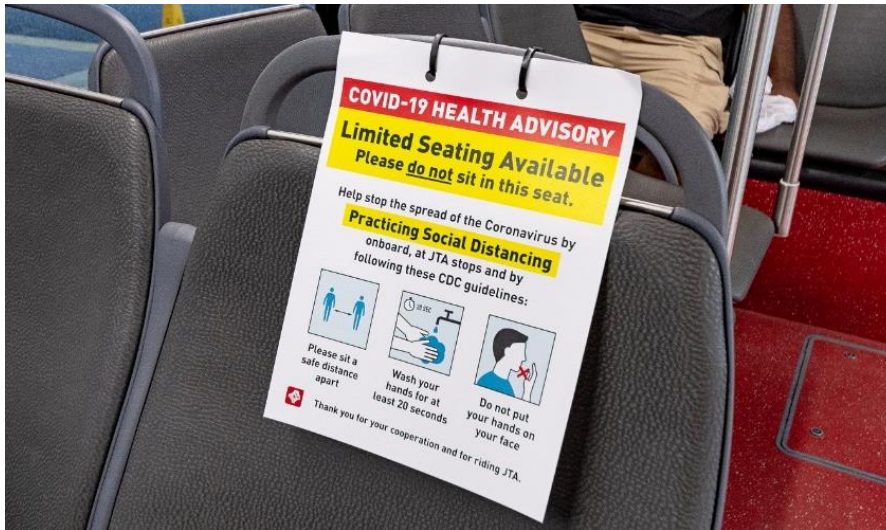

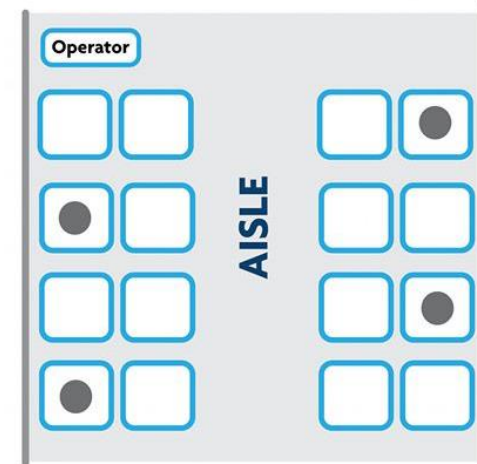


Examples of Social Distancing Measures



CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

Once on board, customers are asked to maintain a distance between themselves and the operator and other patrons and stagger seating as much as possible to maintain the recommended social distance.



USE STAGGERED SEATING MAINTAIN DISTANCE

HART is disinfecting entry ways, fare boxes, steering wheels, operator seats, protective shields, modesty panels, stanchion bars, customer seat backs and hand rails on buses, vans and streetcars. All HART facilities surfaces, door knobs, sinks, faucets, hand rails and other common areas are be disinfected as well as HART amenities.
